Re: Somerville House High Schools Chess Teams Summer Invitational 2018

Please find enclosed an entry form for the Somerville House High Schools Chess Teams Summer Invitational 2018. This tournament will be held on **two** Friday nights.

Dates: 9 March and
16 March 2018
Registration: 6.00pm
Time: 6.30pm-10.00pm (approx.)

NB. All players must register by 6.00pm, or they will not be included in the first round.

All rounds will be played in VPAC at Somerville House, South Brisbane. Included with the entry form is a detailed map of the venue. Please note that there is parking available in the school grounds beneath VPAC. Parking is also available on Graham Street, and in the Mater and Lady Cilento Children's Hospitals' car parks.

Last year over 200 high school students participated in this competition. We hope that this competition will be as well (and as enthusiastically) attended.

This year, rising prices have forced us to increase our fees for the first time in five years. To eliminate the need to provide loose change, we have increased the team entry fee from one hundred to one hundred and twenty dollars, and thus the individual entry fee from twenty-five to thirty dollars. However, fee reductions are still available in exceptional circumstances.

The tournament is divided into four divisions, catering for all levels of play from beginners through to more advanced players. We encourage all schools to enter as many teams as they wish, and in particular, encourage beginners to enter the "Novice" division. Players who have a Queensland Junior rating should enter "C" Grade. Please feel free to discuss this with Patrick Byrom or Connie Pizzato.

We hope that you will try to make every effort to enter by the due date. Several teams travel to our competition from the Gold Coast and early entries will enable the event to start on time, allowing teams from outside Brisbane to catch public transport home.

A canteen will operate each day with a sausage sizzle starting at 6pm.

It is important that there is sufficient supervision of students by either teachers or parents, as at a previous tournament three students were caught in the lift (which cost the school several hundred dollars). Please advise all your students that the use of the lift is prohibited.



RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. A and B Grades will be played as a combined seven round swiss. However, teams in each grade will be eligible only for the prizes in their grade. Teams will be selected for each grade on the basis of the average rating of the four players. As a guide, teams whose players are rated below 1200 will probably be selected for B Grade. Each player will have 20 minutes on the chess clock.
2. "C" Grade will be a nine round swiss tournament. Players will have 30 minutes to complete each game. Adjudication will occur when games go over the allotted time. Players must be rated below 1000.
3. "Novice" Grade will be a nine round swiss tournament. Players will have 25 minutes to complete each game. Adjudication will occur when games go over the allotted time. Players must be rated below 800.
4. Teams will consist of four players in order of strength, with the strongest player on Board 1 and the weakest player on Board 4.
5. **PLAYERS MUST STAY ON THE SAME BOARD THROUGHOUT THE EVENT!**
A reserve player will fill the vacant board. Points will be awarded only if reserve player is from the same school. Reserve players who play in non-school teams cannot gain points.
6. Winning teams in each grade will be awarded a trophy. Board prizes will be awarded in each grade for the highest scoring player on each board.
7. **Organisers reserve the right to allocate teams to a different grade from the one entered. Schools will be advised of any changes prior to the first round (if ALL entries are received on time).**
8. Canteen with sausage sizzle from 6.00 pm.
9. **Early entries will ensure that the event starts on time. All students must register by 6.00pm to play in the first round.**

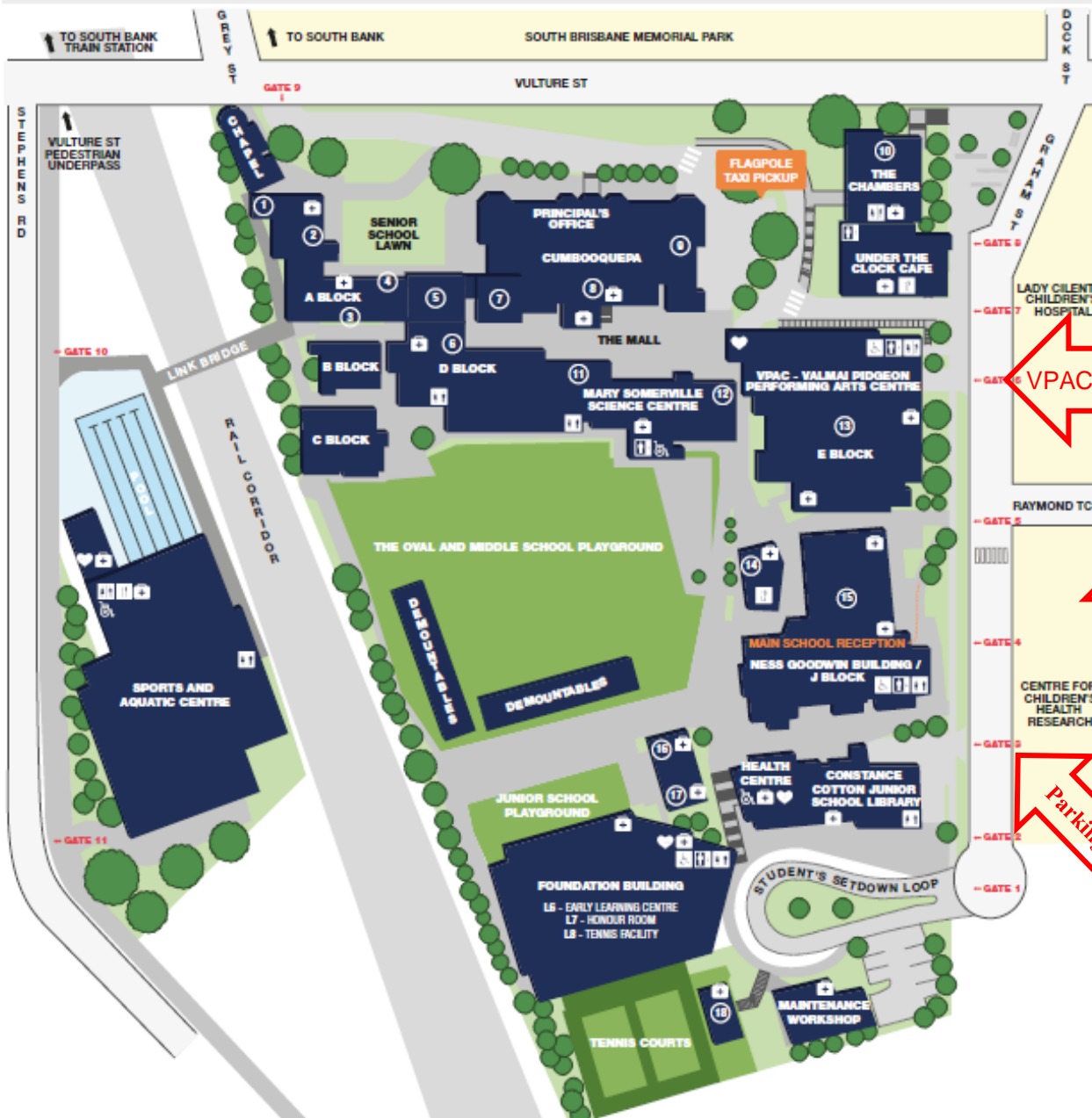
